Opener Miss & Teen– Miss: White jumpsuits and Teen: White Cocktail Dresses with gold stoned belts purchased from Laine Berry of The Royal We. Teens: White dancer booty shorts under their dresses. The booty shorts will be ordered at Teen Workshop in March. Details listed under Production Tab. Shoes will be nude strappy heels. AB Gold Earrings of choice. No necklaces.

Nude Strappy Heels - You will need a pair of strappy nude heels of your choice to be worn in the Opening Number & for the Closing Number.

Activewear/Teen – will be ordered at the March Workshop from Cammi Zimmerman by each contestant and delivered to you at the April Orientation meeting. These details will be listed under the Teen Active Wear tab.

Closer Miss & Teen – Gold Sequined one-shoulder long gown purchased from Laine Berry of The Royal We with nude strappy heels, gold earrings of your choice. No Necklaces. Details under Production Tab.

Talent – Costume of your choice.

Miss Red Carpet Evening Wear & Social Impact Statement– NEW THIS YEAR FROM MISS AMERICA 2.0

Allows a look into a how the candidate exhibits her own personal style, attitude, personality, grace, presence, and confidence while making her own statement about her mission for the job.

- Allows a look into composure, confidence, the attention she captures on the stage, her command of the stage, presence, and how she appears in the spotlight
- Allows ability to judge first impression reaction
- Allows a look at posture and carriage
- Allows a chance to hear a candidate’s presentation of her social impact initiative for social media in a different setting
- Social Impact Statement cannot exceed 10 seconds and will be delivered live into a handheld mic.

Teen Evening Wear & Onstage Question– one competition gown and one off-night gown of your choice with heels of your choice. You are not required to have an extra gown for off-night production and can wear your competition gown if you choose. You will answer your onstage question in your evening gown. Questions will be drawn from a bowl.

Interview & Onstage Question Dress –

- Miss: Business style attire of your choice. Miss Contestants will also wear their interview outfit onstage for Onstage Question which will take place Friday night replacing the past swimsuit competition.
- Teen: “Teen stylish” outfit. Dress as if you were giving a speech to your student body, interviewing for a job at a trendy boutique, or being introduced as the new class president. Acrylic platform shoes are not appropriate for an interview.
